Blue Tee Division:

Flights of 4 teams, "Match-Around" net format - each team plays the other 3 teams in a 9-hole match stroking off the low handicap in the group, 1 point per hole with a 1 point bonus for the winning team (the point is halved if the match ends in a tie) If the flight is tied at the end of the 3 matches, then the head- to- head match-up will be used to break the tie. If a tie still exists, then we will go to a chip-off.

White Tee Division Available if needed

Each of the 4 Flight Winners will participate in the "Shootout" to determine the Champion.

The Shootout format: Alternate shot with the 50% of the team handicap applied to the team score.

Hole #16: 1 team eliminated

Hole #17: 1 team eliminated

Hole #18: 1 team eliminated All ties will be broken by a chip-off

Dear Fellow Members,

I believe I speak for all the Board when I say we are very excited about the 2011 season. I don't know how it's possible, but the golf course and grounds are in even better shape than last season. The pools have been cleaned and painted and look better than ever. Even the old building over by the pool received a fresh coat of paint. And as I write this, we are completing the renovation of the ladies lounge and bathroom areas. Best of all, we start this new season with almost 70 new members!

Of course, we still have our challenges. When the current Board was elected, it was with the clear understanding that our fiscal house had to be put in order. One of our first commitments was to adopt a policy of "pay as you go." At the same time we focused on reducing our operating costs. I am pleased to report they are the lowest they've been at any time in more than ten years! Still, the reality of increasing prices (gas prices last May were at \$2.50, now they hover around \$4.00!) and the demands of properly maintaining our mature facilities require that we implement a relatively modest increase in dues and reestablish the funding for capital improvements.

To help us continue our move toward a balanced budget, dues for Full Members will increase \$19 per month. For Social Members, dues will increase \$15 per month. As I mentioned above, we are also going to reestablish the Capital Maintenance Fund. Contribution to that fund will be \$15 per month and applies to all members. This new structure will go into effect July 1st.

You may be interested to know that in 2000 Full Family dues were \$225 per month. Dues for a Single Golfer were \$150. When adjusted for inflation those same monthly dues would be \$282 and \$188 today. That means dues for Full Family Members have gone up \$6 in the last 10 years. For a Single Golfer there has been no increase at all! Back in 2000, Social Members paid \$116 per month. Today they pay \$84!

All of us on the Board are keenly aware that an increase in the cost of Green Hill's membership is no trivial matter, regardless of how modest. We want to keep Green Hill as affordable as possible. At the same time, we have the responsibility of protecting and nurturing Green Hill, both for our enjoyment today and generations to come. With that in mind, we believe this decision is the best balance of those competing interests.

Thank you to everyone for your continued support. On behalf of the Board and the Green Hill Staff, we wish you and your family a wonderful summer season. As always, if there is anything any of us can do to improve your enjoyment of Green Hill, please let us know.
