Best Attendance: Jane Wade

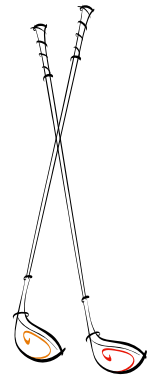
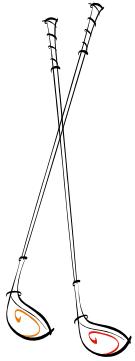

## **President's Corner**

**I would like to take this opportunity to recognize a very special member.**

**Dwight Miller, President of Gillis Gilkerson, Inc., over the years, has given lots of professional advice and assistance to our Club.**

**Last winter when our cart barn collapsed due to the weight of ice and snow, Dwight took on the job of rebuilding the barn. For us, this was a major job. But for Dwight and Gillis Gilkerson, Inc., it was a minor project. Just like any job for his firm, it was handled professionally.**

**There were many aspects of this project. Some of them including things like: removing the debris in a way that did not further damage our golf cart fleet; working with various inspectors to explore various options (and in some cases educating them about those options); finding ways to make the replacement building even better than the original structure without running up the construction costs; recommending and implementing ways to make the structure more energy efficient.**

**The building isn't a place most of us visit, so I'll point out some of the improvements Dwight incorporated – exhaust fans at both ends of the building that reduce the risk of fire and explosion from the batteries in the golf carts (they didn't exist before), installing translucent panels on both sides of the building to improve visibility without running up electric bills, reinforcing the interior perimeter around the floor so errant carts don't damage the walls, and insulating the ceiling (never existed before).**

**On behalf of Green Hill, Dwight negotiated hard with subcontractors to help reduce the cost of repairs. And then he went a step further. He talked to his two partners at Gillis Gilkerson and they all agreed to forego their portion of the fees in order to help Green Hill cover the costs of the repairs and renovations.**

**What Dwight and Gillis Gilkerson did for Green Hill is beyond what is expected of any contractor. We can certainly recommend Gillis Gilkerson for any construction project.**

**The next time you see Dwight, wife LuAnne and children, please thank them for all they have done for Green Hill Yacht & Country Club.**
