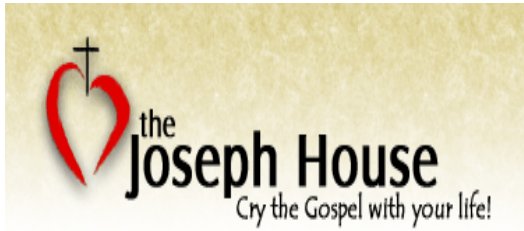

## President's Corner

The volunteer status of our General Manager will change effective October 1, 2010. David Riley stepped forward in March, 2009 for the sum of \$1.00 per month to act as our GM and has continued in that capacity since.

The Board of Directors has contracted with Mr. Riley's firm, Gemini Effect, LLC where he will act as the full time, paid, General Manager.

In making this decision, the Board recognized Mr. Riley's many contributions to the Club. In early 2009 Dave, understanding our cash shortfall and debt problem, developed and then sold the Heritage Membership Classification where members paid \$25,000 to become a lifetime member. Without the \$475,000 from the 19 Heritage Members Green Hill would be a much different place today.

Now Dave has submitted a plan to the Board that focuses on three overriding objectives: (1) Controlling expenses, (2) Developing a superior product and experience, and (3) Exploring and adopting programs and services that will both attract new members and keep the Club relevant for the future.

The Board is committed to making Green Hill the preeminent private country club in the area and believes Dave Riley, with our help, is the right person to make that happen.
